Great introduction to a lot of areas in the space of computer learning for games

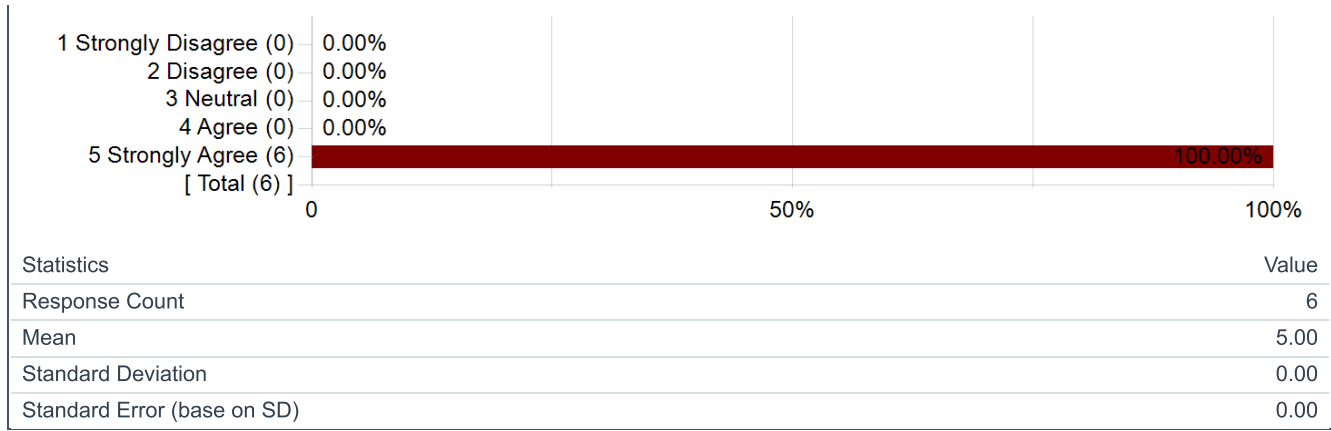
Great Course. Instructor provided excellent introduction and guidance to literature studies for learning in games.
